

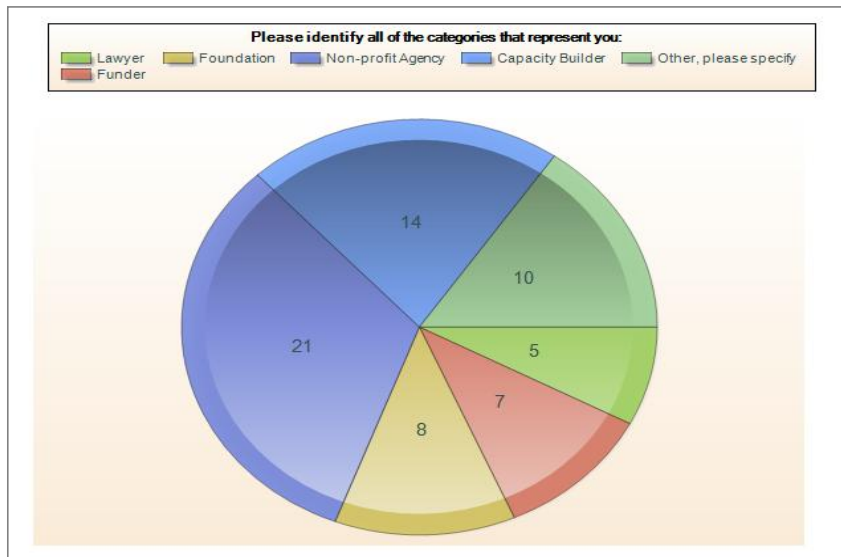

1. Respondent Affiliation



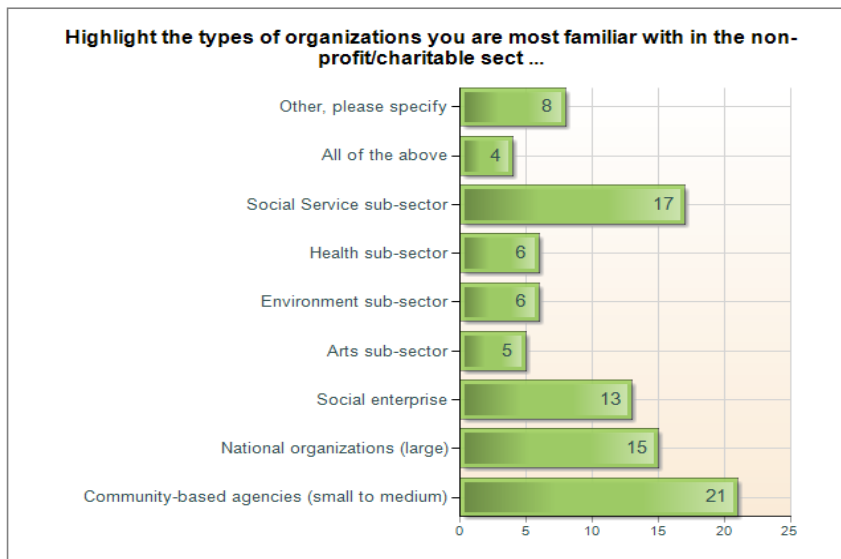
RESPONDENTS' AFFILIATIONS

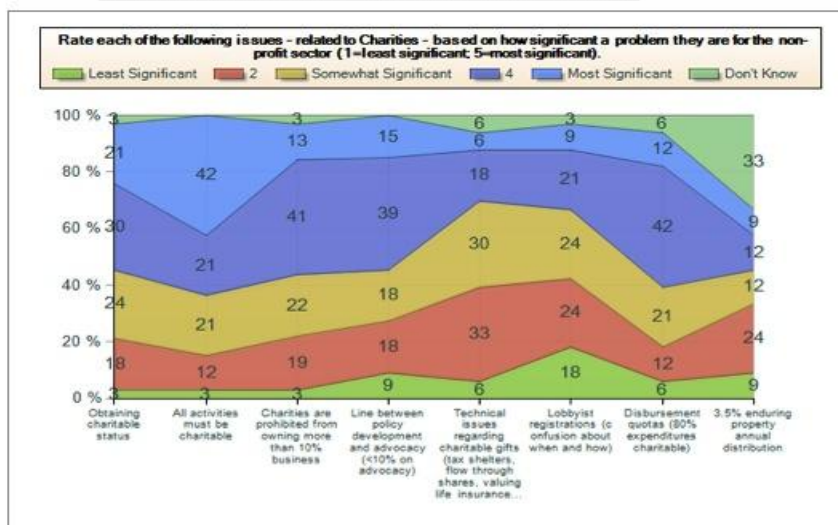
2. Organizations that respondents are familiar with

ORGANIZATIONS RESPONDENTS ARE FAMILIAR WITH

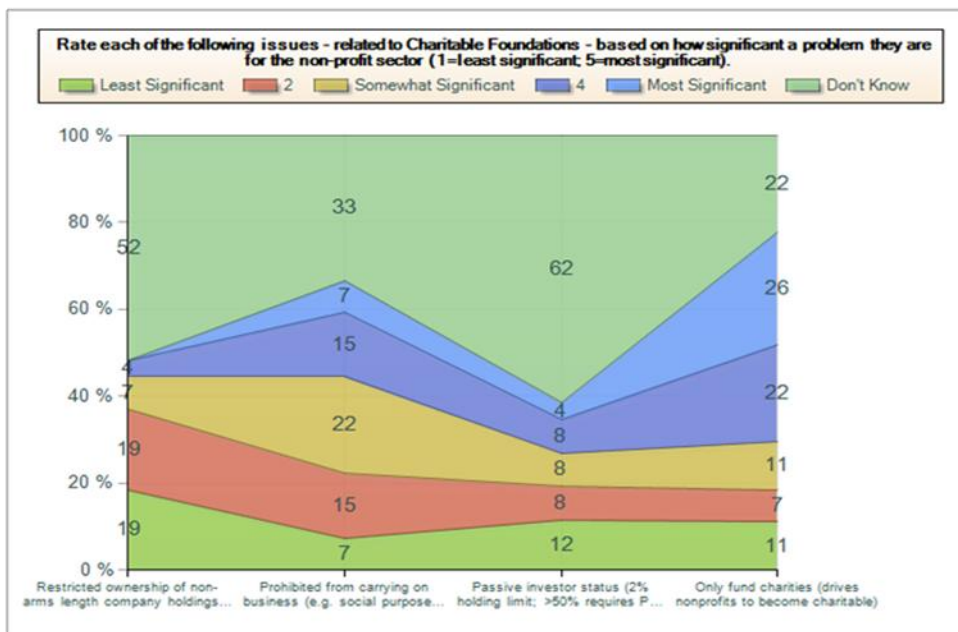

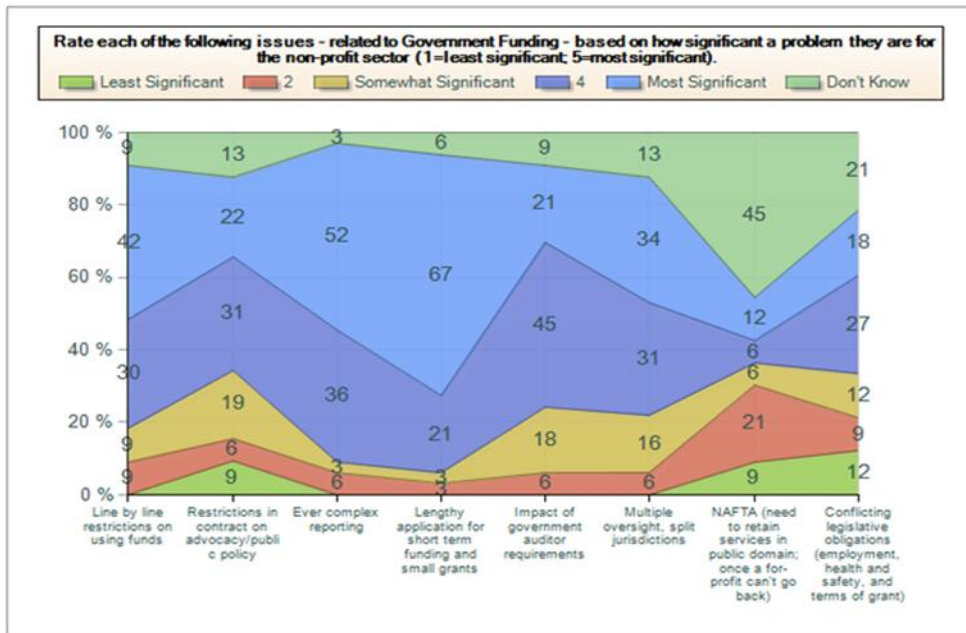
